It was disappointing that the National Championship was not able to go ahead at Discovery Coast, Qld due to Covid 19. I hear that those people who did attend the alternative event had a great time.

By now you should all know that Eyre Peninsula, South Australia, has been selected as the venue for the next A.A.A. National Championships and Convention and we invite you to attend this event.

Headquarters will be at the Port Lincoln, Ravendale Community Sports Centre, Stamford Terrace. There is plenty of parking, nice clubrooms where social events can be held and weigh-ins on the oval in front of the rooms. Food and drinks will be available at all weigh-ins.

Nominations for each event will be at Headquarters, with the exception of casting which will be held at North Shields Sports Association.

The opening ceremony will be combined with Old Friends at headquarters on Monday 20th March. Old Friends Night is where all competitors and registered social members are invited to catch up with old friends or make some new friends.

There have been some changes made to the original proposal in the program booklet that was sent out late last year. Rock and Beach; The Drummond Point boundary has been moved to the north point of Hall Beach. We have also added the Port Lincoln foreshore. The boundaries are from the Yacht club to the Axel Stenross Boat Ramp. Before you ask the main commercial jetty will not be included due to safety concerns. This area was only added to make the event accessible for young children and the physically challenged competitors.

The Social committee is planning some different and varied events to entertain those who do not participate in the fishing events.
